The Saudi Tadawul Group (STG) serves as the parent company for a suite of specialized subsidiaries, including the Saudi Exchange, a dedicated stock exchange business; the Securities Clearing Center Company (Muqassa); the Securities Depository Center Company (Edaa); and Wamid, the innovation arm of the Group. Founded in March 2021, following the transformation of the Saudi Stock Exchange (Tadawul) into a holding group structure, the Saudi Tadawul Group has successfully integrated its subsidiaries to enhance the appeal and competitiveness of the Saudi capital market. Guided by its vision to become a world-leading holding group, the organization is committed to fostering a diverse Saudi capital market and serving as a vital bridge between global investors and regional economies.



Shanghai Stock Exchange

Shanghai is Mainland China's first city to see the emergence of stocks, stock trading and stock exchanges. Stock trading started in Shanghai as early as the 1860s. In 1891, the Shanghai Share Brokers Association, an early form of stock exchange, was established in Shanghai. Later in the 1920s, with the founding of the Shanghai Securities Goods Exchange and the Shanghai Chinese Securities Exchange, Shanghai emerged as the financial center of the Far East, where both Chinese and foreign investors could trade stocks, bonds, and futures. In 1946, the Shanghai Chinese Security Exchange was renamed the Shanghai Securities Exchange Co., Ltd. Later in 1949, all securities trading venues were closed down.

This discussion will explore the Kingdom's evolving economic priorities, opportunities for international cooperation, and the role of strategic partnerships in supporting long-term growth, investment, and economy development.

Discussions will focus on the evolution of corporate bonds and sukuk markets, the role of credit ratings and market infrastructure, and opportunities to expand market participation and improve access to capital.

This panel brings together investment banks, advisors, and capital markets practitioners from both markets to work through the practical realities: what the IPO pipeline actually looks like, how depository receipt frameworks and dual-listing mechanisms function in practice, what institutional investors on each side require before participating in the other's offerings, and where the real legal, disclosure, and market access barriers sit.

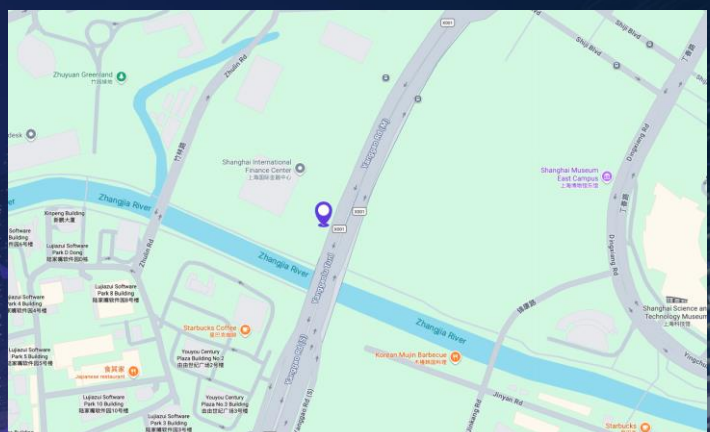
